

REGULATORY UPDATES

Financial Services Commission (Nominee Shareholders and Directors) Regulations, 2025

The Financial Services Commission advises the public that the regulations governing Nominee Shareholders and Nominee Directors have now been enacted. These regulations address, among other matters, the following key areas:

- 1. Requirement:** As a new regulated activity, individual or entities must be licensed to provide nominee services, and
- 2. Transitional Requirement:** Pursuant to regulation 17 (2), all existing Registered Agents and relevant individuals must submit a report to the Commission, within six (6) months of the commencement of the regulations. This report should contain:
 - Steps taken to identify nominee relationships,
 - Compliance status of all companies, and
 - A list of non-compliant companies, with reasons or justifications.
